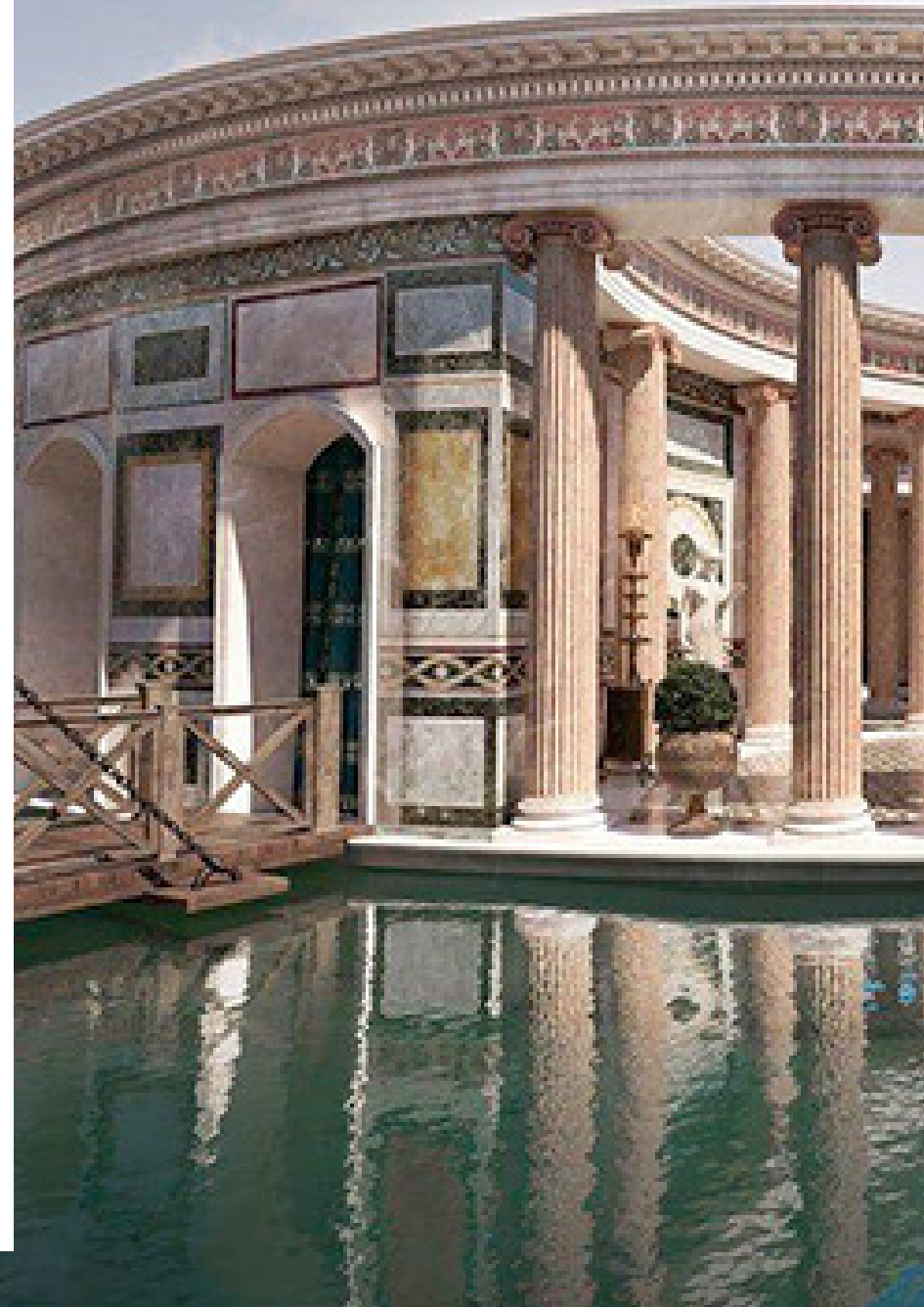


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# VILLA ADRIANA

Built for Emperor Hadrian, it still today embodies the splendour of the centres of power in ancient Rome. In Tivoli, Hadrian's Villa (Villa Adriana) was designed to be a home for the Roman Emperor Hadrian in 117 A.D. Construction began on top of the foundation of a pre-existing villa that belonged to his wife Vibia Sabina.

The area was chosen for its abundant waters and availability of four aqueducts that passed through to Rome: Anio Vetus, Anio Nobus, Aqua Marcia and Aqua Claudia. One can still find here the sulphur water springs (the Acque Albule) that the Emperor enjoyed – today's Tivoli Baths
